Importation of animal feedstuffs of non-animal origin from third countries

All consignments of animal feed of non-animal origin (raw materials and additives, premixes and compound feed) entering France must be presented for veterinary inspection at a SIVEP designated point of entry (DPE).

DPEs are listed in the ministerial order of 18 May 2009.

Importation of such products does not require any specific health certification with the exception of consignments subject to particular safeguard measures:

- Regulation (EU) no. 2015-175 (guar gum from India PCP risk)
- Regulation (EU) no. 884-2014 (aflatoxin risk)
- Regulation (EU) no. 2016-6 (Japan risk of caesium contamination)

(Important note: regulatory changes apply from 14 December 2019)
