







TRAVELLING WITH A DOMESTIC CARNIVORE

STEP 1: DECLARE YOUR DOMESTIC CARNIVORE NO LATER THAN ON SITE CHECK-IN:





Type (dog/cat/ferret)



The number of animals, which must be five or fewer specimens per person (unless proof is provided of registration for a sports or cultural event)



The number of the pet micro-chip



The date of vaccination against rabies

STEP 2: ON BOARDING, PRESENT YOUR DOMESTIC PET CARNIVORE FOR CHECKS BY THE FERRY COMPANY OR TUNNEL PERSONNEL FOR THE FOLLOWING:





Scanning of the micro-chip



Verification of the sanitary certificate issued by the UK authorities



Ensure your vehicle is identified (sticker or hanger, etc.)

STEP 3: ON DISEMBARKATION, ON ARRIVAL IN FRANCE:





Go to customs

Dogs identifiable as belonging to breeds such as Staffordshire Terrier, American Staffordshire terrier (Pit Bull), Mastiff (Boerboel) or Tosa, and not registered in a Breed Book, are classed as category 1 attack dogs. Their importation into France is prohibited.

TRAVELLING WITH A PET OTHER THAN A DOMESTIC CARNIVORE



For all other types of pet animal (birds, rabbits, reptiles, etc.), <u>up to the</u> <u>limit of five specimens per person</u>, you should go to customs in order to present the required sanitary certificates.
