THE AFRICAN SWINE FEVER VIRUS KILLS PIGS



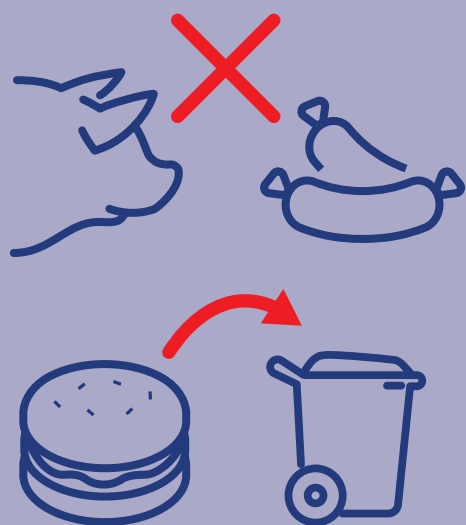
The African Swine Fever Virus (ASFV) is a highly contagious disease in pigs and wild boar. There is no vaccine for this disease. It poses no risk to human health, however, it can cause severe agricultural economic loss.

Travellers, road hauliers do not spread the disease!
