GENERAL OBJECTIVES:

Through a variety of educational methods (lectures, cases studies, field visits and study trips), the ENSV Veterinary Education Courses aims to:

- Promote global governance by stimulating exchange in veterinary practice and experience;

- Participate in veterinary institutional and technical capacities; further cooperation of partner countries to develop mutual understanding.

The challenge is to allow participants to gather and share their experience through the presentation and use of different concepts; to question their own personal practice regarding OIE' and Codex Alimentarius standards. These courses are combined with the OIE Strategic Plan for capacity building activities, in terms of management, law and governance of Veterinary Services.

AUDIENCE:

TUITION FEES:

 1 - Prevention of antimicrobial resistance (one-week session in France + 2 days online learning) 	2 500 €
2 - Animal health and welfare (2,5 week session in France including a European Study Trip)	6 000 €
3 - Seafood & freshwater product inspection (one-week session in France Including visit of inspection sites + 2 days online learning)	3 000 €

Tuition fees do not cover living expenses in Lyon, travel to or from France or insurance and visa costs. Session 2 tution fees includes transportation, accommodation and meals during European study trip in Geneva, Brussels and Paris.

Living expenses in Lyon are about 100 \in a day (accommodation and meals). Flights and travel expenses are paid by the attendees and are not the responsability of ENSV.
